Please note that pre-entries are accepted until 9pm the Wednesday before the show. We will check the email at 9 pm for final entries. Post entry fees will apply after that time. Pre entry fees are 10.00 per class, post entry fees are 12.00 per class.

Horse Show Rules

- 1.) Management reserves the right to refuse to receive any exhibitor and or horse before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor or horse without being liable for compensation.
- 2.) Any act of discourtesy to a judge or any other official of the show on the part of any owner, trainer, rider or groom will immediately disqualify any horse or horses with whom they are associated and entry fees for prior to the start of the show. such horses will be forfeited.
- 3.) Classes may be combined or cancelled at the discretion of the show management.
- 4.) In all classes over fences, management may designate the order of go. The one minute rule will be enforced if necessary with entry fees being forfeited.
- 5.) The show management will not be responsible for any accident or injury occurring to animal, person, or property and a signed release must be received in the show office before an exhibitor will be allowed to show.
- 6.) Proof of negative coggins will be required. Exhibitors may bring a copy into the show office and we will keep it on file throughout the year.
- 7.) All riders must wear ASTM approved headgear with an attached and fastened harness and all exhibitors must wear a shoe with a small heel at all times while mounted.
- 8.) A 25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
- 9.) Stalls will be available for 30.00 per night. Shavings must be ordered at least one day before the start of the show. A non stabling fee of 15.00 per horse will be charged for each animal that participates and does not rent a stall.
- 10.) Schooling begins at 3pm on Friday and ends at 8am on Saturday morning. The lights in the indoor arena will NOT be turned on Friday evening. There will be a mandatory 5.00 schooling fee charged on all horse/rider combinations.
- 11.) Dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds.
- 12.) Champion and reserve champion ribbons and prizes will be awarded in each division. First through sixth place ribbons will be awarded in each class. To be eligible for year end awards, dues must be paid in advance and the rider must complete at least two shows from the organization. Points will be awarded on a 10,6,4,2,1,.5 basis.
- 13.) Each division must fill at least three times throughout the year for points to count for a high score award at the end of the year.
- 14.) We ask each of the competitors to limit the number of classes that they ride in to 10 per horse rider combination, and 12 total per horse.
- 15.) A once a year membership fee of 10.00 will be charged to each horse/rider combination at the show.

Division Specification:

Walk Division: Open to riders in their first year of showing.

Walk-Trot Division/Groundrails division: Open to riders who have not cantered in any horse show.

Walk-Trot-Canter: Open to inexperienced horses and riders.

Crossrails Division: Opened to inexperienced riders or horses/ponies. Once the horse/rider combination competes over fences exceeding 2', they may no longer compete in this division. May trot or canter the fences.

Baby Green Hunter: Open to inexperienced horse or ponies who have not shown over fences higher than 2'.
